Lessons from the Life of Noah

Genesis 6:8-9, 6:22, 7:1 & 8:15-9:1

But Noah found favor in the eyes of the LORD. ⁹This is the account of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, blameless among the people of his time, and he walked with God.

²²Noah did everything just as God commanded him.

¹The LORD then said to Noah, "Go into the ark, you and your whole family, because I have found you righteous in this generation.

¹⁵Then God said to Noah, ¹⁶"Come out of the ark, you and your wife and your sons and their wives. ¹⁷Bring out every kind of living creature that is with you—the birds, the animals, and all the creatures that move along the ground—so they can multiply on the earth and be fruitful and increase in number upon it." ¹⁸So Noah came out, together with his sons and his wife and his sons' wives. ¹⁹All the animals and all the creatures that move along the ground and all the birds—everything that moves on the earth—came out of the ark, one kind after another. ²⁰Then Noah built an altar to the LORD and, taking some of all the clean animals and clean birds, he sacrificed burnt offerings on it. ²¹The LORD smelled the pleasing aroma and said in his heart: "Never again will I curse the ground because of man, even though every inclination of his heart is evil from childhood. And never again will I destroy all living creatures, as I have done. ²²As long as the earth endures, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night will never cease." ¹Then God blessed Noah and his sons, saying to them, "Be fruitful and increase in number and fill the earth.
